

## **PMSL “Cardless” Dual Meet Timers and Head Timer**

At the beginning of the meet, each lane will have a stack of “Timer Sheets”. There is one sheet per event. Instead of the swimmer or a runner handing you a card, you will record the times on these sheets.

You will be required to compare the swimmer to the name on the sheet. If the name doesn't match, record the name of the swimmer who actually swam on the sheet. If the Clerk-of-Course has moved a swimmer, the swimmer will hand you a “Reseed Form”. Those forms get turned in to the Head Timer with the timer sheets.

You will record the times on the timer sheets as you used to do on the timer cards. But, you will not write down or circle the “official time”. That job will now be done by the Head Judge. The timer sheets will be collected by the Head Timer after the end of the event, and not after every heat.

It is suggested that the timer sheets be collected by the Head Timer after the start of the first heat of the following event. Thus, the time between all heats will be short.
